6. Health Services

The duties of a school nurse includes the following three areas:

Well-Being and Safety continued Health Services

The Health Services Department will:

- Stay current in the latest developments of COVID-19
- ▶ Provide list of resources available to answer appropriately questions from students, parents and staff using the TEA, CDC, Texas Department of State Health Services, the BISD policies, procedures, and other resources.
- Complete online trainings such as CPS, Allergies, Bloodborne pathogens, Epilepsy, Suicide Prevention, Behavior Threat Assessment, and will serve as a liaison to have all of these training as a staff development in their respective schools.
- Available to assess staff members working in the schools making sure that the CDC public health recommendations are being followed. For example wearing masks, social distancing, the self-assessment of temperature and COVID-19 symptoms.
- Serve as the primary contact for health issues and workplace concerns



Well-Being and Safety continued Health Services

The school nurse will:

- Assist each campus on calling the parents of students who are absent.
- ► Ensure continuous communication with parents of students who have medical diagnosis, to make sure they are taking their medication and to assist parents with referrals or community resources as appropriate.
- ▶ Be available for ARD's, 504"s and SPED meetings and make the appropriate recommendations to assist the student to succeed.
- Provide online education to students and staff on handwashing, importance of wearing a mask, use of hand-sanitizer, diabetic care, growth and development, dental care and other age appropriate trainings.
- Provide trainings to campus staff on the use of thermometers
