7. Food and Nutrition Services

- ▶ Curbside Meals will be distributed at all (34) elementary campuses throughout the district.
- ▶ All BISD FNS will be screened using Smart Temp App answering 4 health yes or no questions to ensure objective screening to safeguard the health of our staff preparing foods for our vulnerable population
- ▶ BISD Communication to Parents must include:
- ▶ Mail or hand out student specific ID Barcodes for all enrolled BISD students
- ▶ Denoting that the Student ID Barcodes form letter must be prominently displayed on windshield
- ▶ Announcing Meal times will be from 10:00am - 1:00pm
- ▶ Students are not required to be in vehicle
- ▶ Each enrolled BISD student can receive a hot lunch and a cold breakfast for the following morning

Curbside Feeding Procedures

- ▶ Parent will drive up and have Barcode ID form prominently displayed on windshield
- ▶ If parent does not have the letter, FNS will research database based on the students name, ID number, Date of Birth and home campus
- ▶ Meals will be pre-packed, heat sealed in a 3 compartment tray.
- ▶ Parent will be asked to select, by pointing, from a choice of milk, fruit and second vegetable (none of which are required to be taken) but offered to complete the meal patterns
- ▶ FNS will provide meals in a bag and place on a cart, pushed towards the vehicle for the parent to pick up to have a touchless delivery and barcode scanned for a touchless transaction and count the meals to maintain program integrity of only 1 meal type per student
- ▶ Cart will be sanitized between customers
- ▶ All meals served meet state and federal requirements set for by USDA

Well-Being and Safety continued Food and Nutrition Services

- ▶ Transitioning to In-Person Instruction Feeding
- ▶ FNS will follow CDC guidelines to provide meals when BISD is ready for in-person instruction. Meals will be prepacked in bags or trays to maintain food safety
- ▶ Breakfast in the Classroom (Pk-8th)
- ▶ Breakfast in the Hallway (9-12)
- ▶ Touchless transaction lunch, requiring ID barcoded cards for all students
- ▶ Curbside meals will continue for families opting for virtual instruction
