# **PreK-5th Elementary Summer School Program**

**Program Overview:** To provide a series of programs for all students who need summer instruction and credit for grade advancement.

#### I. Bilingual

- A. <u>Bilingual Enrichment Program</u> for *current* and *preregistered identified* English Language Learners entering Kindergarten and 1<sup>st</sup> grade in the 2017 2018 school year
- B. Prekindergarten and Kindergarten English Language Learners Currently enrolled:
  - PREKINDERGARTEN: <u>Currently enrolled</u> identified Pre-Kindergarten English Language Learners eligible for Kindergarten in the 2017 - 2018 school year
  - 2. KINDERGARTEN: Currently enrolled identified Kindergarten English Language Learners eligible for 1<sup>st</sup> grade for the 2017- 2018 school year
- C. Pre-Registered for Kindergarten and 1<sup>st</sup> grade for the 2017 2018 school year and NOT currently enrolled in BISD
  - PREKINDERGARTEN: Children identified and preregistered for Kindergarten as English Language
     Learners with parental approved placement into the BISD Bilingual Program for the 2017 2018 school
     year are eligible for summer school.
  - KINDERGARTEN: Children identified and preregistered for first grade as English Language Learners with
    parental approved placement into the Bilingual program for the 2017 2018 school year are eligible
    for summer school.
- II. Grades 1-5 Summer Program is for district students who failed to be promoted based on District Policy EIE Local.
  - 1. Students must be in grades 1 through 5
  - Dyslexia students who are deemed eligible by the Section 504 committee. Dyslexia teachers will
    be available at each site to work in conjunction with summer school teachers to provide
    additional support for eligible dyslexia students.

NOTE: Students who failed to be promoted due to excessive absences are not eligible for this program.

III. Student Success Initiative (SSI) Program is for students who failed to meet the SSI Requirement in grade 5 during the 2016 – 2017 school year. Accelerated instruction will be provided for the third STAAR Administration in Mathematics and/or STAAR Reading. Priority for summer 2017 are the 5<sup>th</sup> grade students who did not pass the 2017 STAAR Reading and/or Mathematics. SSI preparation classes will begin on Thursday, June 8<sup>th</sup> and will end on Friday, June 30<sup>th</sup>.

# Middle Schools Grade 6, 7, and 8 Regaining of Credit Program

#### **Program Overview**

#### I. Regaining of Credit Program

#### A. Regaining of Credit Program

- The district grading procedures require students to pass each of the core subject areas with a yearly average of 70% and pass electives with a 70% (composite) overall yearly average.
- BISD students who failed to meet district promotion criteria are eligible to attend the regaining of credit program.
- Students who failed to be promoted due to excessive absences are not eligible for the program.
- Only currently enrolled BISD students are eligible to enroll in the Regaining of Credit Program.
- Regaining of Credit Program will begin on Thursday, June 8th, and end Friday, June 30th.
- NOTE: 2016 2017 BISD enrolled 8<sup>th</sup> graders who took Algebra I during the academic year, and did not meet mastery are eligible to attend the regaining or EOC test preparation at the designated summer high school site.

#### **B.** Course Offerings:

- Math, Science, Social Studies, English, Reading, ESL I, English SL, Art, and Health.
- If the student failed an elective during the regular school year, the student will need to select from the summer school electives offered in order to regain an elective credit.
- Dyslexia teachers will be available at each site to work in conjunction with summer school teachers to provide additional support for eligible dyslexia students.
- C. <u>Student Success Initiative (SSI) Program:</u> Eighth grade students who failed to meet the SSI Requirement (Grade 8 STAAR Mathematic and/or STAAR Reading) during the 2016 2017 STAAR administration(s) are eligible to attend Grade 8 STAAR Reading and/or STAAR Mathematics accelerated instruction classes. SSI preparation classes will begin on Thursday, June 8<sup>th</sup> and end on Wednesday, June 21<sup>st</sup>.
- **D.** <u>Texas Success Initiative (TSI) Summer Bridge/Prep Program:</u> Eighth grade students interested in passing the TSI in reading and math in order to be eligible for dual credit courses at the District's Early College High Schools are eligible.

Math TSI Bridge/Prep: 7:30 am - 11:15 am

Prerequisite: Must have completed Algebra I in the 8th grade

Reading TSI Bridge/Prep: 11.45 am - 3:30 pm

Prerequisite: None

Students may participate in one or both TSI Summer Bridge/Prep Programs. All participating students will be given the opportunity to TSI test in the area(s) completed at the end of the program.

Program Overview: To provide a series of programs for all students who need summer instruction and regaining of Credit.

#### I. Regaining of Credit Program

- A. Regaining Credit Program: Only currently enrolled BISD students who failed course(s) during the 2016 2017 school year are eligible to enroll in the Regaining of Credit Program.
- B. Students who failed to be promoted due to excessive absences are <u>not</u> eligible for the program. Regaining of Credit Program will begin on Thursday, June 8<sup>th</sup>, and end Friday, June 30<sup>th</sup>.
- C. <u>Course Offerings:</u> Language Arts, Math, Science, and Social Studies required for graduation are offered in the Regaining of Credit Program.
- D. <u>LUCHA<sup>TM</sup> Program Language Learners at the University of Texas at Austin's Center for Hispanic Achievement</u>
  LUCHA Program: Currently enrolled ELLs in BISD who meet the following criteria may enroll in summer to complete courses
  Ells who are missing 1 or 2 credits <u>required</u> for summer graduation or are in need of regaining credit. Courses offered are
  English, math, science, and history.
- E. <u>BISD Migrant Students</u> with a current eligibility supported by a Certificate of Eligibility (COE) on file at the Migrant Office, may also regain credits by utilizing the migrant lab available at their designated summer school site. Migrant students must register with their respective campus counselor. Hosting Sites: Hanna Early College High School.
- F. <u>Dyslexia Students:</u> Dyslexia teachers will be available at each site to work in conjunction with summer school teachers to provide additional support for eligible dyslexia students.

Students with disabilities who have difficulty retaining skills during long school holidays and/or summer and who require a significant amount of time, as per federal and state requirements (34 CFR part 300, TAC Chapter 89), to regain previously mastered skills are eligible. BISD Special Education students, in grades PreK through Grade 12, are eligible to receive extended school year services as determined by an ARD committee.
