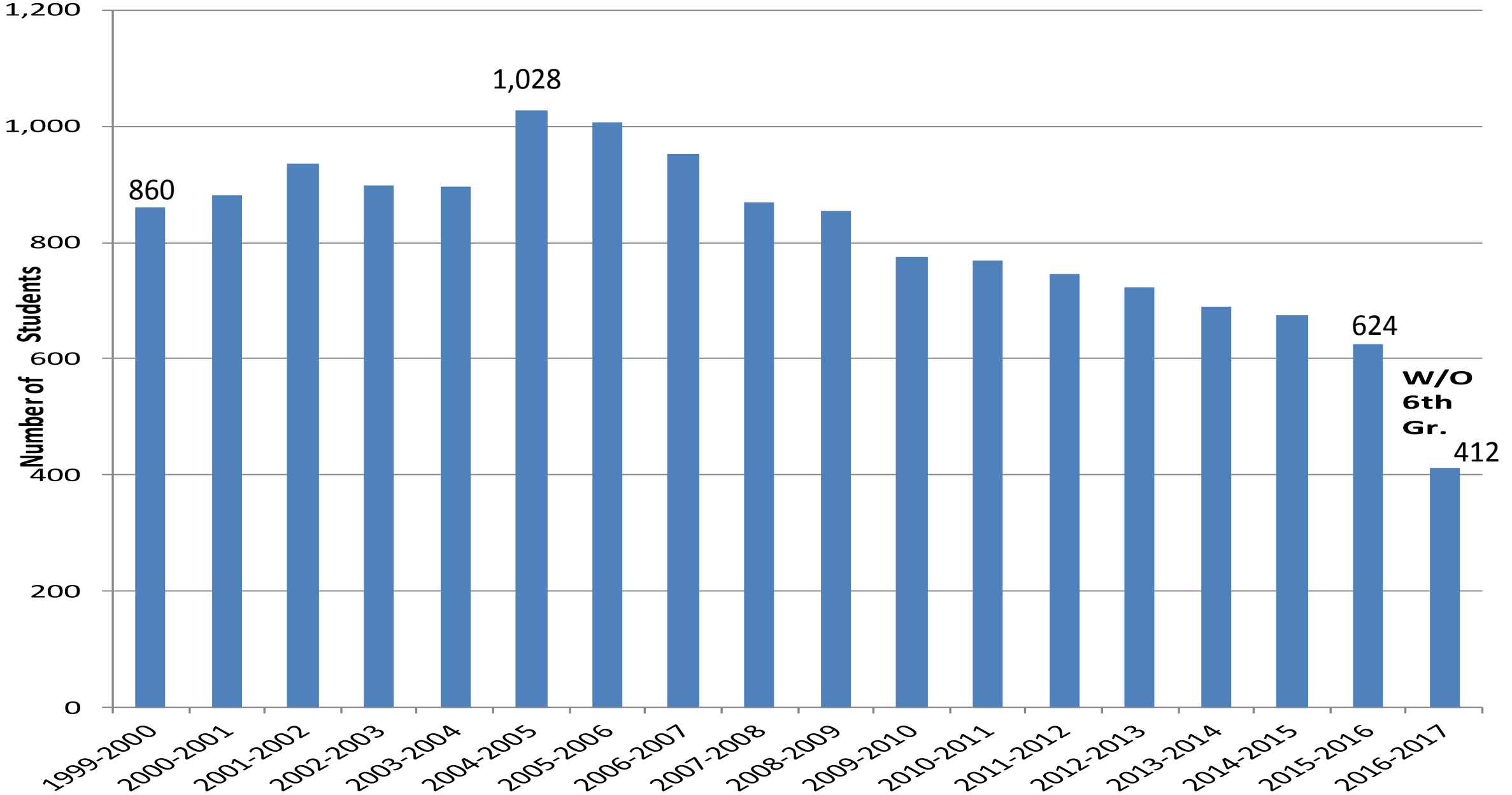

Cummings MS Transformation Plan: Critical Points

- There is a need for more classroom space for our overage middle school and high school students at Brownsville Learning Academy (BLA).
- The expansion of Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs for all students is a priority.
- The current Webb campus, centralized location for CTE personnel and programs requires extensive repairs and is at full capacity (100 students in the morning and 100 students the afternoon).
- A district priority is to expand CTE programs to increase licensures and/or certificates offered to BLA high school students so they are truly college and career ready.

PROSPECTIVE MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDENTS



- There are 113 middle school students at BLA (2016-2017). Approximately 45 are on track to become 9th graders.
- Next year there will be another 72 students that will be eligible to attend the BLA Middle School (2017-2018).
- BLA MS could have up to 185 students.

PROSPECTIVE HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS



- There are 262 high school students at BLA (2016-2017). Approximately 45 are on track to graduate.
- Next year there will be another 167 students that will be eligible to attend the BLA High School at Cummings (2017-2018).
- BLA HS could have up to 384 students.

Review of Future Pathways in Technology Early College High School Program (P-TECH) (Cummings)

- The P-TECH creates a seamless pathway for students through strong collaborative efforts between a school district, an institution of higher education and one or more employers.
- The P-TECH program integrates high school, college and workplace learning.
- Students have the option of earning their high school diploma and a two-year, industry recognized postsecondary degree within four to six years.
- P-TECH students will obtain valuable skills and knowledge that will facilitate completion of a four year degree or entry into a well-paying occupation in the Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM) fields. This includes the health related fields, as well.
