## COVID-19 Stadium Concession Protocols

These protocols are designed to give guidance to our parent/booster organizations as they prepare for concession sales at football games. It is important to ensure that these guidelines are followed and that procedures are developed to help mitigate the spread of COVID-19.

- The concession area will be limited to no more than six people to ensure the opportunity for social distancing at a minimum of six feet apart.
- All participants must wear a mask or face shield at all times.
- All participants should pre-screen themselves by taking temperature and assess symptoms prior to volunteering in the concession stand. Those exhibiting symptoms such as cough, fever, sore throat, shortness of breath, fatigue, congestion or runny nose should stay home and should not participate.
- The use of hair and beard restraints is highly recommended. Hair restraints may include items such as hats, hair covering and nets, beard restraints, and clothing that covers body hair.
- Have participants wash hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after going to the bathroom, before eating, after blowing their nose, coughing or sneezing, or after touching high touch surfaces.
- If soap and water are not readily available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol. Always wash hands with soap and water if hands are visibly dirty.
- If gloves are used, they must be changed frequently. The use of gloves is not a substitute for washing hands.
- Only prepackaged items can be sold. No food can be prepared on site or delivered from an outside vendor. Individual prepackaged items must be sealed from the manufacturer. Examples of prepackaged items are individual sealed bags of potato chip/popcorn, individually sealed cookies (not home baked), and packaged candy.
- Counters and other high touch areas should be cleaned and disinfected as frequently as possible.
- It is recommended to develop a process to minimize contact during transactions. Platforms such as Venmo, Zelle, Apple Pay, Google Pay, and CashApp would be best to minimize the need for contact and for cash.
- If cash is to be handled, it is optimal to designate one to two people to handle cash transactions. These individuals should wash their hands after every time they handle cash.
- Try to help customers maintain good infection control and social distancing by finding ways to encourage spacing between customers while in line for service or check out.
- All concession areas will cease all sales and begin closure at the start of the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter.

This document should be considered a fluid document. These guidelines will be adjusted as needed to help mitigate the risk of viral spread at Brownsville ISD Athletic events taking place at Sams Stadium.
